**Support** is necessary to hold students accountable. Communication and understanding from the school to home is what will be expected to help students build independence. Staff are prepared to instruct, manage, and clarify this information with students, and more in-depth descriptions are in handbooks.

Students have choices, but choosing to participate in classrooms is not one of them. A teachers' expectation can vary class to class, or setting to setting. Students may not like or get upset with required responsibilities throughout the day, but rules, expectations, and structure need to happen to manage students. Homework will be assigned and responsibilities met. Please help your student understand these school requirements.

## Blue Slip / SWIS Form

- Major infractions by a student
- Can be filled out by any staff member in the building
- The staff member who fills out the form is responsible for contacting the parents of that student by phone call or email
- Parents will be contacted on the day that the incident occurred and a form was filled out
- A blue slip may result in loss of privileges such as field trips, reward trips, recess, or after school
  activities, Encore, Lego League, ect.. A blue slip will result in detention after-school or during
  lunch. Multiple blue slips will keep students in detention for the remainder of the week.
- If parents have questions about the incident it is best to contact the staff member that filled out
  the slip as they have the most accurate information to give, Mr Berry does not always have
  specific knowledge of the incident.
- If you have a concern, please be aware that when contacting the staff member during school
  hours, you may not receive an immediate response. However, they will get back to you when they
  have a prep time or after school
- Students need to be held accountable and will receive a consequence for actions while under our care or responsibility.

## **Purple Slip / Teachable Moment**

- Minor infractions by a student
- Usually something that can be a quick fix if addressed immediately
- Parents will not be contacted for each individual purple slip filled out
- If the issue becomes repetitive then communication to parents may be necessary.

## Transportation/Bus - 3 strikes

- 1. Verbal reminder
- 2. Assigned seating
- 3. Lose bus privileges
