

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF
PINCKNEYVILLE COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT #101, PERRY COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, HELD ON THE 26th of NOVEMBER, 2018, AT 6:30 P.M. IN THE
PINCKNEYVILLE COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING IN THE PINCKNEYVILLE
SCHOOL DISTRICT.

The Board of Education of Pinckneyville Community High School District #101, Perry County, Illinois, met in a regular session on the 26th of November, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. at the Pinckneyville Community High School in that district. The following officers and members of the Board were present: Greg Thompson, President; Lisa Stanton, Secretary; Brian Kellerman, Jennifer Robb, Kyle Pursell, Greg Bigham, and Jeff Suchomski. Keith Hagene, Superintendent, Tony Wilson, Principal, and Penny Corn, recording secretary, were also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted and PCHS Mission Statement was read by President Greg Thompson.

Mr. Wilson recognized All-Conference volleyball players Lynlee Lindner, Elaine Shaneyfelt, and Hallie Waggoner; All-South Cross Country member Liam Oliver; State qualifying girls Cross Country team; All-Conference football players Chase Fulkerson, Dalton Kitchen, Ben Restoff, Stetson Lappin, and Lucas Downard; All-Conference golfers Kally Mayo, Graci McDaniel, Megan Breslin, and Sarah Breslin; and finally, congratulated Megan Breslin for being named Southern Illinois Golfer of the Year. He praised everyone for their dedication to their sports and academic successes, and expressed his pride in how they all represent PCHS and Pinckneyville.

Mr. Wilson discussed our school report card, praising the advances which have been made in many areas. He also gave a brief AD report.

Jake McCann and Earl Klieden were on hand to explain and discuss the bus shed bids.

Mr. Hagene presented the tax levy proposal and read the Resolution as follows: Be it resolved by the Board of Education of Pinckneyville Community High School District No. 101 that the following taxes by and the same are hereby levied against all the taxable property in said district as the same are hereby levied against all the taxable property in said district as the same is equalized and assessed by the Department of Revenue for the year 2018; Education Fund \$1,094,800; Operations and Maintenance \$297,500; Transportation \$142,750; Working Cash \$59,510; Municipal Retirement \$65,000; Social Security \$90,000; Fire Prevention and Safety \$59,510; Tort Immunity \$325,000; Lease Levy \$59,510 and, Special Education, \$23,750. Total operating levy of \$2,217,330.

There were no FOIA requests or out of state/overnight trips this month.

Mr. Hagene conducted a first reading of policy updates. He then read a resolution authorizing the sale of personal property (desks) no longer needed for school purposes.
