The goal of the Lyme School's lunch program is to provide healthy meals to our students.

This requires our lunch program to be financially secure, and we need your help to achieve this goal.

Parents & Caregivers - You are responsible to:

- Pay for purchases made by your child/children in our school cafeteria, and;
- To communicate with us regarding any financial need that exists so that solutions can be sought to settle your balance.

Please maintain a positive balance in your family/household account. Your suggested minimum balance is \$10.

- Statements are sent regularly to parent/caregiver email on file. Please check your spam!

You can fund your family/household account by:

- Sending a Personal Check (made out to Lyme School Lunch), or Cash in a sealed envelope with your child's name on it to the front desk at the school.

- Siblings and families share a balance. Making a contribution funds all associated accounts in the family/household.

If you think that your child may qualify for Free and Reduced price school meals, you can fill out an application at any time.
