## IV. STUDENT HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICIES & PROCEDURES

## School Based Health Clinic

Marion School District has partnered with East Arkansas Family Health Center in opening a school based health center on the campus of Marion High School. The health center is available to all students grades K-12, for care of illness and minor injury, as well as routine wellness services including immunizations and preventative care. Mental health services are also available. Students must be evaluated by the campus school nurse for referral to the health clinic, plus parent permission must be granted prior to students being transported and evaluated at the health center. Payment for services at the health clinic are billed to student's insurance and/or Medicaid. For more information, contact the health center at 870-739-5137.

## Medical: Illness at Home

Students who are sick with a contagious illness such as fever, vomiting, open skin lesions, head lice or conjunctivitis (pink eye) **MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL.** The student must be free of symptoms for 24 hours, without the use of fever reducing medications, before returning to school, and /or have a release back to school from a physician.

## Medical: Illness/Accident at School

Students who become ill or require first aid should report to the school nurse's office. If the student's temperature is 100.0 degrees or above, a parent/guardian will be called to pick student up. Parents/guardians must make sure the school has current phone numbers where they may be
