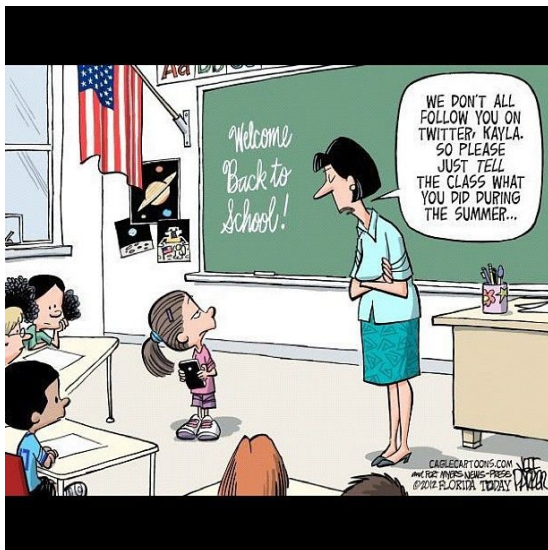

Not only that, but teachers are truly excited about some of the programs we are providing this year.
