

- 1. We understand that DAEP student will not be allowed to use the telephone unless it is an emergency.
- 2. We have received a copy of the Tyler County DAEP Handbook and understand the Rules and Guidelines set forth in this document. We understand that all students attending the DAEP will be accountable for their own behavior and will be subject to the disciplinary consequences outlined in this handbook.
- 3. We understand that assignment to the DAEP is the last option for this student to receive a public education prior to expulsion. Success will be completely dependent upon the behavior, attitude, and actions of the student. In order to take advantage of this opportunity, this student must participate in and successfully complete the classroom course work assigned.
- 4. Rest is very important for good classroom performance, but we understand that this student will not be allowed to sleep in class at any time.
- 5. We understand that drug testing may become necessary and we consent to drug testing if it is necessary.
- 6. We are aware and understand that one of the provisions in the TCDAEP Handbook discipline Code indicates that Corporal Punishment may be an option exercised by the TCDAEP Administrator. Corporal Punishment (is / is not) permissible for this student.
- 7. We understand the Trespass restrictions for students assigned to the DAEP as stated in the Handbook.
- 8. We grant permission to the Tyler County Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (TCDAEP) and Woodville Independent School District (WISD), to make video tapes, photographs, and/or sound recordings separately or in combination, of our child, for the safety and protection of our child in the classroom. Tyler County DAEP Community Service Program

- 1. The Community service program is designed to help students who have long term sentences but have near perfect behavior on our campus return to school earlier.
- 2. This process is student by student basis, Offenes type and behavior risk level will determine eligibility for community service. No student is entitled to community service, it is earned with good behavior, good attendance and a positive attitude. Anyone can be denied the opportunity for community service at the discretion of the DAEP Director.
- 3. The program is limited to students who have a term of over 30 days, or Students with 30 day terms. Students with 30 plus days of DAEP placement will become eligible for community service after the first successful 30 day have been completed. Students with only a 30 day placement will be eligible for service on the 24th day of service.
- 4. Any student who comes to DAEP with a term of over 30 days will become eligible after 30 days of service with a clean service record while here, thus making them eligible to gain two days of placement for one day of community service while at the DAEP. Any Student with a 30 day term will become eligible on the 24th day of placement. The student will complete 3 days of community service to earn one day credit for each day they perform community service. Thus this reduces a 30 day placement to 27 day placement .Their behavior and attitudes will determine eligibility for community service. Effectively saving them three days of placement time.
- 5. Who is not eligible for community service Students with an extreme behavior placement, students who display negative behavior while here on campus and students who are repeat offenders. (note: a student can be removed from or added to community service at any point for any reason the Staff a DAEP deems necessary). Chronic absenteeism will result in community service program removal.
- 6. Community service will be limited to the Transportation facility for now. Students will have jobs such as sweeping and cleaning the buses, Sweeping floors, raking leaves or picking up trash, even washing off bus windshields. They will be supervised by Coach Williams or myself at all times. and there will never be more than 3 together.
- 7. Students will work for 45minutes to an hour and for every day they do this they will receive 2 days for 1 day of DAEP services.
- 8. My hopes are that Mr. Holligsworth can begin to come by and get a student or two, maybe a couple of days a week and take them to clean up trash after a game, scrape gum off bleachers, work in flower beds and whatever we need. DeWayne and I have discussed this some already.
