Commencement Ceremony

The district shall conduct a commencement ceremony for members of the senior class at the end of the school year. Participation in the ceremony is a privilege, not a right, and the superintendent or his/her designee may prohibit students who have violated conduct rules from participating in the ceremony as a consequence for the misconduct.

Students who are to receive a diploma must meet all graduation requirements (i.e., completed the required coursework or achieved the goals set in the students individual education plan) as established by the Board of Education by the Friday before the ceremony, in order to take part in the Graduation ceremony. Students receiving a 'certificate of attendance' may also participate in the Graduation ceremony with the approval of the High School Principal. This approval must be granted before the Friday before the ceremony.
