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Homebound Instruction and Off-Campus Instruction

The school district may provide a student with instruction in his or her home or other off-campus location under the following circumstances:

- If the students IEP or 504 team determines that homebound instruction is appropriate;
- If the student is physically or mentally ill or injured and unable to attend regular classes and the superintendent or his/her designee had determined that a program of off-campus instruction is appropriate, after conferring with the student's parents, teacher(s) and/or physician; or
- Under other circumstances which the superintendent deems to be appropriate.

19 Homebound and off-campus instruction may include a variety of in-person
20 and distance learning services, as determined appropriate by the
21 superintendent or relevant educational team. The superintendent or
22 relevant educational team shall periodically review individual off-campus
23 instructional programs and shall only continue them as long as they are
24 educationally appropriate.
