2 **Student Cell Phone and Other Electronic Devices**

4 Students may use cellular phones or other electronic devices while at school according
5 to individual building rules, so long as they do so safely, responsibly and respectfully
6 and comply with all other school rules while using these devices.
7

8 By bringing their cell phones and other electronic communication devices to school,
9 students consent to the search of said devices by school staff when permitted by law.
10

11 Students may not have cell phones or electronic devices on while they are in locker
12 rooms, restrooms, or any other area in which others may have a reasonable expectation
13 of privacy.
14

15 The taking, disseminating, transferring, or sharing of obscene, pornographic, lewd, or
16 otherwise illegal images or photographs, whether by electronic data transfer or
17 otherwise (including things like texting, sexting, e-mailing, etc.) may constitute a crime
18 under state and/or federal law. Any person engaged in these activities while on school
19 grounds, in a school vehicle or at a school activity will be subject to the disciplinary
20 procedures of the student code of conduct.

22 While on school property, as a school activity or in a school vehicle, students may not
23 use their cell phones or electronic devices to bully, harass or intimidate any other
24 person as governed by the student code of conduct.
25

26 Students shall be personally and solely responsible for the security of their electronic
27 devices. The district is not responsible for theft, loss or damage of any electronic
28 device, including or any calls or downloads.
29

30 Students who violate this policy may have their cell phones or electronic devices
31 confiscated immediately. The administration will return confiscated devices to the
32 parent or guardian of the offending student, after meeting with the parent or guardian to
33 discuss the rule violation. Students who violate this policy may, at the discretion of the
34 school's administration, be subject to additional discipline, up to and including
35 suspension or expulsion.
