Schley County Middle/High School Faculty/Staff Dress Code

The following dress code will apply to all certified and non-certified employees including teachers, counselors, paraprofessionals, secretaries and administrators at Schley County Middle/High School. It is to be applied for all of the days students are present, parent-teacher conferences and professional development days and/or the full length of the employee's contract.

Appropriate Attire Required

Appropriate Clothing Includes:

Males

- Pinpoint or button down dress shirt
- Knit shirt, turtleneck, and mock turtleneck, polo style collared shirt
- Slacks or khakis
- Dress shoes, boots, athletic shoes, and casual shoes
- Socks
- Necktie
- Sport coat or sweater
- Holiday, theme, or school shirt, school sweatshirts or pullovers

Females

- Jumper, dress, skirt (professional FIT & KNEE LENGTH)
- Dress shoes, casual shoes, dress sandals, boots and athletic shoes
- Blouse, knit shirt, cotton shirt, turtlenecks, mock turtlenecks, and sweaters
- Holiday, theme, or school shirt, school sweatshirts or pullovers
- Dress "crop slacks" that are loose fitting
- Slacks or khakis

Inappropriate Dress

- No revealing clothing shall be permitted such as halter tops, tank tops, low cut tops that over expose the chest area or tops, or expose the stomach area
- No spaghetti strap tops
- No visible body piercing other than the ears
- Flip flops are not acceptable footwear
- Jeans of any color are not appropriate (unless special jean day by administration)

Reasonable exceptions will be allowed for special "spirit days" and special activities outside the classroom at the discretion of the Principal/Supervisor.
