



What is a Schoolwide Title I program?

Case Avenue Elementary School is a considered Title I Schoolwide program. A Title I Schoolwide program is a method of delivering Title I services in eligible schools. It allows the school to address the educational needs of children living in impoverished communities with comprehensive strategies for improving the entire school so every student achieves high levels of academic proficiency.

Schoolwide programs have latitude to determine how to organize their operations and allocate the multiple funding sources available to them. Schoolwide programs can use all allocated funds to increase the amount and quality of learning time. In this way, they can embrace a high-quality curriculum, according to a comprehensive plan that ensures all children meet the state's challenging academic common core standards. Schoolwide programs serve all children in a school. All staff, resources, and classes are part of the overall Schoolwide program. The purpose is to generate high levels of academic achievement in core subject areas for all students, especially those students most in need.

Who are Title I students?

They are students who will succeed when given some extra instruction. Their teachers identify the students as needing additional help in reading and/or math based on their test scores and performance. Those who show the greatest educational need are served first.

How are parents involved?

- 🐾 Parents are notified about the school's Title I program
- 🐾 Parents are given **Right-to Know** notification
- 🐾 Parents and students receive a **School-Parent Compact** that spells out the goals and shared responsibilities of the child, school and parents for student success.
- 🐾 Parents are invited to participate in Parent Involvement Committee meetings and help to formulate the **Title 1 Parent Involvement Policy**.
- 🐾 Parents may participate in Title I meetings, workshops, and other learning opportunities. Parents are provided information about Title I via newsletters, conferences, and the Parent Involvement Plan.

What can parents do?

- 🐾 Make sure your child attends school daily.
- 🐾 Share a love of learning and set a good example by reading, writing letters and/ or lists, comparing prices, and general school involvement.
- 🐾 Make learning fun by playing educational games, visiting the library, and listening to and talking with your child.
