ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES...

To report an absence, call our office attendance mailbox @ 684-8891 available 24 hours.

This will make school personnel aware of the absence but only a doctor's note can EXCUSE an absence. Turn any doctor's notes into our office to be kept on file.



School attendance is mandatory in the state of Michigan. Students with 12 absence or more will be reported to our county truancy officer.

Student arrival after 8:45am will be considered a ½ day absence. Students leaving school before 2:45pm will also be considered a ½ day absence.
