SCHOOL HOURS, DROP OFF/PICK UP PROCEDURES, AND ABSENT INFORMATION for the 2019-2020 School Year

Arrival/Drop-off in the morning:

Students may be dropped off at the SOUTH playground fence entrance located at the south end of the building starting at 7:55am. There is NO supervision prior to that time. Students and parents are not allowed to enter the building.

Dismissal/Pick-up in the afternoon:

Students can be picked up at the SOUTH playground fence entrance (same location as arrival). Students will exit the playground doors and meet you at the fence. Parents will need to park in the south parking lot and walk to the fence to meet their child. Parents are not allowed on the playground at the end of the day or during dismissal so please stand on the south side of the fence and wait for your child.

In case of inclement weather, such as rain, please follow our normal drop-off and pick-up procedures.

There is a BUS ONLY lane located at the north end of the building. Please respect this area and keep this lane clear and open. It is for the safety of all of our students.

Please call the office by 2:30pm to notify us if there is a change to your child's normal end of the day routine.
