

---PDA Policy Parkers Chapel High School---Public display of affection is prohibited. While already a policy, more description and consequences are given here: Students are not to touch each other throughout the school day or at school events. There should be absolutely no physical contact, and students using couches should leave space between them. Examples of PDA include but are not limited to: hugging, kissing, holding hands, touching faces, sitting on another student's lap, and putting legs across other another student's lap. Also, students are not allowed to bring or use blankets at school. Failure to comply with this will automatically result in a lunch detention. Teachers are to report PDA after correcting the behavior. D-hall will be given by the principal or the dean of students. Repeat offenders will be disciplined as deemed appropriate by the principal or the dean of students by following discipline protocol outlined in the student handbook.

---When using headphones connected to a phone or mp3 player, headphones or ear buds should only be put in one ear. This is for safety and so that students can hear their name if called.

--Students may not lie down on school furniture or the floor. Students should be in an upright position while sitting.

---For students to be checked out by phone, it has to be for a doctor's visit, legal issues, or emergency issue. The parent must specify which one. Parents must come to the office and physically sign students out for any other reason. This includes before, during, and after the lunch period.
