



# Frequently Asked Questions



## ***What happens at Beyond the Bell?***

After a light snack and homework period, students will participate in Math, Reading, Physical Education or a wide variety of experiences designed to expose them to the many talents, hobbies, and skills present in our community. Art and technology skills will also be explored during the enrichment period. Highly qualified teachers will run the sessions.

## ***Are there any fees for participating?***

Students may attend the Beyond the Bell program free of charge, it is a fully funded 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning Community Grant program. The only expectation is that they attend 3 days a week. When student attendance drops below 60%, the student will be dismissed from the program for the remainder of the year.

## ***Who is invited?***

All district students in grades PK-8 are invited to attend.

## ***When does the Beyond the Bell meet?***

After-school programming is offered **five days** each week when school is in session. The program begins immediately after school and ends at 5:30 Monday-Friday. The program will not be in operation on days school is not in session such as vacation, inservice or inclement weather days.

## ***Is transportation available?***

District provided transportation will be offered to ALL students. Routes will be dependent on participation. You still have the opportunity to pick up your student at 5:30 pm if you choose.

## ***How do I register my child?***

Simply complete the registration form and submit it to the North Crawford Elementary School office. Registration form can be found in the Elementary Office, school website or via email.

**Registrations received after September 13, 2019 will require a full day of administrative wait time between enrollment and attendance.**

## ***What if my student can't attend every day of the week?***

Regular attendance is recommended for best learning but we understand flexible scheduling. Students may come only on certain days (ie. Mon., Tues., Thurs.). When registering, note days students will attend.

## ***What are the themes for each day?***

The themes for each day are: Math Monday, Reading Tuesday, Workout Wednesday, Twisted Thursday and Fun Friday.
