Application Guidelines

The Bascom Communications – Greg Merryfield Memorial Scholarship Fund has been established in honor and recognition of Greg Merryfield. This scholarship is awarded to a student who has best demonstrated, in the judgment of the scholarship trustees, the same quality of character and hard work that Greg exemplified in his life. That is namely a mature sense of hard work, moral values, and devotion to family and work.

One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded annually during awards night to one student from Seneca County.

The scholarship trustees will select the winning finalist. Interviews with applicants may be scheduled in the event more information is needed about the applicant.

No information except that contained on or relating to the application is used in the selection process. The scholarship trustees may verify information with the high school guidance counselors.

Any senior graduating from a Seneca County High School meeting the following criteria may apply:

1. 2.5 or higher GPA.
2. Acceptance to a two or four-year college or university.
3. Participation in a community, extracurricular or other organizational activity.

A typed essay of 250-350 words shall be submitted with the attached application form, along with one letter of recommendation.

If a graduating senior applicant does not meet the qualifications, application may be submitted with a written explanation of why the scholarship trustees should consider the application.

Questions should be directed to your guidance counselor, who will contact the scholarship trustees to obtain a ruling or explanation.
