Dear Guidance Counselor:

Again, this year the Seneca County Retired Teachers Association will award a \$500 scholarship to a high school senior who resides in Seneca County and will graduate from an accredited high school who is planning to pursue a career in the field of education. Please let any interested and eligible students from your school know about this award and encourage them to apply. Please notice that applicants must live in Seneca County.

All funding for the 2019 grant is obtained through voluntary SCRTA member contributions and the amount will be \$500. We are sure that this will help a deserving student to buy books or pay some other college expenses. The recipient will receive the grant money at the conclusion of their first college grading period in which a 2.5 grade point average or better is achieved. The award will be made during the second grading term of the college or university.

The application must be submitted no later than April 12, 2019. The application packet is to include the enclosed application form, answered questions, a high school transcript, two letters of recommendation, and a brief essay. The application and the other materials submitted with it will not be returned to the applicant.

The winner will be notified around May 17, 2019. The winner and a parent or guardian will be invited to the June SCRTA luncheon as our guests, and the winner will be asked to make a few remarks about their plans for the future.



Please answer the following on as many pages as needed. Please note the topic for each entry on your application form.

1. Tell us about your family.
2. List your high school achievements that you consider the most important such as honors, awards, leadership roles, etc.
3. List your high school activities. Which do you think were most important to you and why.
4. List your school volunteer services which were most important to you. Include how much time was involved with each service.
5. List your community volunteer activities and services in which you were involved and how much time was involved with these activities or services.
6. What school, volunteer or community service experience was most meaningful? Explain why?
7. Share any employment experiences you have had such as type of work, place, duration of time, etc.
8. Which school, volunteer or employment experiences will be especially helpful to you in your career? Please explain why?
9. Do you expect to receive other scholarships or grants and if so, what are they?
10. Include anything extra which you think the committee should know about you that has not been asked in the previous questions.

Also include with this application:

- (1) a certified copy of your most recent high school transcript,
- (2) two letters of recommendation,
- (3) an essay where you describe more about yourself. Discuss why you are planning a career in the field of education, what influenced you in your decision to pursue an education career, and what do you hope to accomplish after you obtain your degree. Your essay will be judged on clarity of thought, your ability to express ideas, and grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Explain why you should be selected to receive this scholarship.
