American Society of Military Comptrollers Crown of Maine Chapter The Robert J. Poiesz Memorial Scholarship

BACKGROUND

In 1999, The Crown of Maine Chapter of the American Society of Military Comptrollers established its first scholarship fund. In 2006 the fund was renamed the Robert J. Poiesz Memorial Scholarship for a former ASMC Chapter Scholarship Committee Chairman who passed away in 2005. Robert served in the United States Air Force for 23 years. After retiring from military service as a Master Sergeant, he earned his MBA. He worked at the Defense Finance and Accounting Service in Limestone from 1996 until his death. He was a lifelong advocate for education, teaching both adult education and college-level accounting classes and providing formal training and guidance to his co-workers. He was pursuing his doctorate at the time of his death. Robert was also an advocate for community service. After his years of military service he served on the Presque Isle City Council as both a council member for two years and vice chairman for one year.

OBJECTIVE

The objectives of the ASMC Crown of Maine Chapter Robert J. Poiesz Memorial Scholarship are to recognize outstanding graduating high school seniors for academic achievement and to provide financial assistance to seniors in order that they may accomplish their future educational goals.

AWARD CRITERIA/SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- be outstanding Applicant must an graduating high school senior in the final half of his/her school year within six months of the application deadline of March 18, 2011. Applicant must be entering a college or a university as a full-time student. Special consideration will be given to applicants who plan on entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management (business administration, economics, public administration, computer science, operations research related to management, accounting, financial finance).
- Applications must be submitted on the official ASMC Crown of Maine Chapter Robert J. Poiesz Scholarship Form. Incomplete applications or submissions that do not follow the submission criteria will be disqualified.
- Applicant must have two letters of recommendation from: (1) a high school principal, guidance counselor or academic dean and (2) a high school teacher.
- Applications will include only the information requested in the application.
- Application packets will be stapled in the top left-hand corner and no other binding is permitted.

AWARD SELECTION PROCEDURES

Applicant's scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, career and academic goals and financial need will be considered and must be documented in a letter of recommendation and summarized on the scholarship form. Scholarship recipients will be notified in May by mail; no phone calls please.

The Crown of Maine Chapter of the ASMC will award four scholarships in the amounts of \$2,000, \$1,000, and 2 for \$500. Scholarships will be presented to the selected student(s) by the ASMC Crown of Maine Chapter President either during the student(s)' awards ceremony or at a special ceremony to be held at the Defense Finance and Accounting Services Notification of the Limestone field site. student(s)' second semester selected college/university enrollment will be required before disbursement of the scholarship check(s).

DEADLINE

Applications must be postmarked no later than March 18, 2011. No exceptions to this deadline will be allowed. Any applications received with a postmark after this date will not be considered for selection. No applications by fax or e-mail transmission will be accepted.

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

In addition to the Crown of Maine Chapter scholarship, an entry may be made to the National Scholarship Program. ASMC awards eleven scholarships each year, one \$3,000, five \$2,000 and five \$1,000 scholarships.
