MINUTES OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE 08/01/2019

A workshop was held on Thursday, August 1, 2019 in High School Library.

School Committee Chair Dr. Douglas called the session to order at 5:08 pm. Present were Dr. Douglas, Ms. Clancy, Ms. Bae, Dr. Dillon and Mr. Fiore. Mr. McCrann and Ms. Severson were absent. Ms. Sarah Rapport was also present.

Ms. Bae moved, and Ms. Clancy seconded, to convene in executive session in accordance with RI General Laws 42-46-5(a)(2) to conduct a work session on collective bargaining with the National Education Association Barrington (NEAB). The motion passed 3-0.

At 5:35 pm, Ms. Bae moved, and Ms. Clancy seconded, to adjourn executive session. The motion passed 3-0.

Dr. Douglas announced that the minutes for the executive session are sealed and no votes were taken.

At that time, Ms. Rapport departed and Mr. Messoro, and Principals Tracey McGee, Tracey Whitehead and Patricia Tolento joined the meeting.

Workshop

Using the 2018-2019 scorecard, the District presented the results from 2018-2019 and used data to make suggestions for the 2019-2020 goals. The School Committee and Administrators co-developed a draft for the upcoming school year. Dr. Dillon will incorporate the 2018-2019 results into a report and will draft a recommended 2019-2020 scorecard aligned with the five-year strategic plan. Ms. Clancy and Dr. Douglas will use that data to develop a communication tool for the public.

School Committee Business

1. The Health and Wellness Policy was read for the second time.

Ms. Bae motioned, and Ms. Clancy seconded, approval of the revised Health and Wellness Policy. The motion passed 3-0 with all members present voting in the affirmative.

2. The school committee members discussed a recent vote by the Town Council to add a member of the Planning Board to the Ad Hoc Field Advisory Committee membership. Lengthy

discussion including concerns about the size of the committee as well as the charge and function, as well as overall governance ensued.

Ms. Bae moved, and Ms. Clancy seconded, approval of the addition of the planning board member to the Ad Hoc Field Advisory Committee. The motion failed 0-3, with all three members voting against.

Dr. Douglas will reach out to the Town Council president to discuss the decision.

Ms. Clancy moved and Ms. Bae seconded adjournment of the meeting at 8:58 pm. The motion passed 3-0 with Dr. Douglas, Ms. Clancy, and Ms. Bae voting in the affirmative.
