***Congratulations on your upcoming high school graduation!!*** I would like to take an opportunity to introduce you to the National Farmworker Jobs Program (NFJP)!! The NFJP assists seasonal/migrant farmworkers (hired hand farm/ranch laborers) in obtaining permanent, full time employment through education and training opportunities.

Have you done any farm or ranch work in the last 2 years for which you earned wages for? Are you planning on attending a post-secondary education training center or seeking full-time employment? ***If you answered yes, you qualify for services with our program!!***

We assist individuals in obtaining skills, training & education, who have earned income wages on a farm or ranch, within the last two years, as a primary source of income.

Services may include, but are not limited to: education, training, emergency assistance and/or cost of living expenses, such as rent, gas, food, job search, On-the-Job Training (OJT), referrals to other outside agencies/resources and etc. ***We also provide assistance (student stipends) to post-secondary students who are attending a 2-year Vocational School or who are in his/her last two years of another college or university (4-year program).***

Contact me today to see if you qualify and to determine your eligibility!

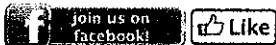
