8. New look to Lincoln Lutheran stationery


Our hope is that you embrace the changes and are excited where God is leading the ministry of Lincoln Lutheran.

Boys and girls track teams qualified for the State Track Meet. On May 22nd, the high school girls track team won the Class C State Championship!



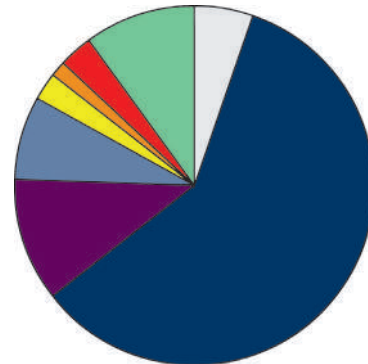

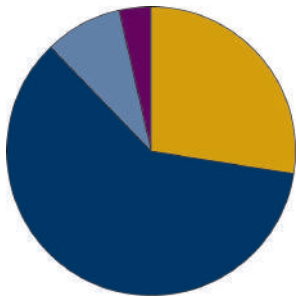

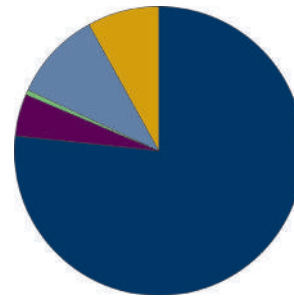
