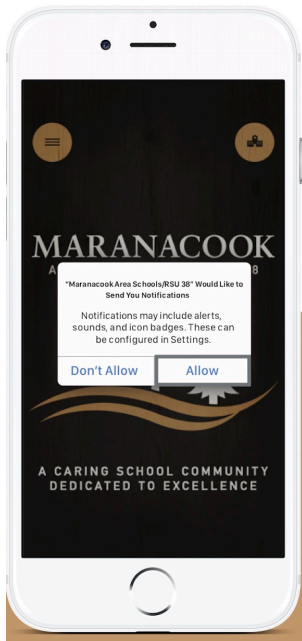
Children and Parents are invited to attend

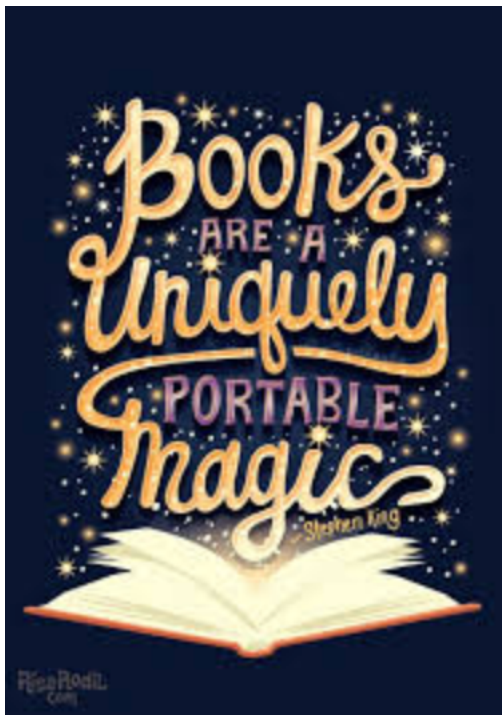
