- ✓ Strengthen systematic RTI to ensure ALL students are showing growth
 - Teachers meet with RTI team quarterly to discuss student progress
 - Speech Therapist included in RTI team quarterly when speech is discussed Classroom teachers and Special Education teachers collaborating to monitor student learning progress (Tier 3)

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING & TIMELINES

Ongoing professional learning for all classroom teachers, special education teachers, speech therapists, literacy interventionists, and specialty teachers

- Professional Development on testing accommodations for all teachers through monthly PLC's and faculty meetings
- Training for general education and special education teachers in the areas of Depth of Knowledge, RISE, PLCs, Word Study Training (third and fourth grade), Identifying essential standards in Reading, and creating common formative assessments. Sonday training for intervention staff and special education teachers. Summer 2019 and embedded throughout 2019-2020.
- Capturing Kids Hearts training for all teachers. Summer 2019 and ongoing.
