School-Parent Compacts

The compacts will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students, and teachers.

Every parent will receive a compact to keep at home. During parent-teacher conferences and other parent meetings the compact will be reviewed and discussed.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Ruskin Elementary will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement to support student learning. Ruskin Elementary values the contribution and involvement of parents to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Ruskin Elementary will support parent engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised?

Ruskin Elementary welcomes parent input and comments at any time during the school year. Parent feedback will be used to review and revise the parent engagement plan and the school-wide plan for the next year. Both plans are posted on the school website for parents to view and post feedback. We also distribute an annual survey to ask parents for their suggestions and feedback on the use of the 1% funds set aside for parent engagement. Parents can also give feedback during various parent meetings, workshops, the spring input meeting with the School Improvement Team and school leaders to review and revise the school-wide plan for the upcoming school year.

Who is it for? EVERYONE !

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Ruskin Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of all parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

Parents receive a copy at the beginning of the school year. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan from the Title I Parent Engagement Coordinator and view it on the school website.

What is Title I?

Ruskin Elementary is identified as Title I school-wide. This means the school receives federal funds to support efforts to challenge all students to meet state academic standards and assessments.

Ruskin will provide opportunities for parents/families to participate in programs to help their child be academically successful. As a Title I school, we will work with all parents to develop a written parent engagement plan.

- Work with parents to develop relevant trainings and helpful presentations to educate staff on the importance of parental engagement.
- Provide necessary materials and handouts for parents at conferences, meetings and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child’s achievement.
- Collaborate with community leaders and business groups to increase participation and awareness of the school parental engagement plan an activities.
- Collect feedback from parents at events in order to respond to parents’ requests for support for parental engagement activities.

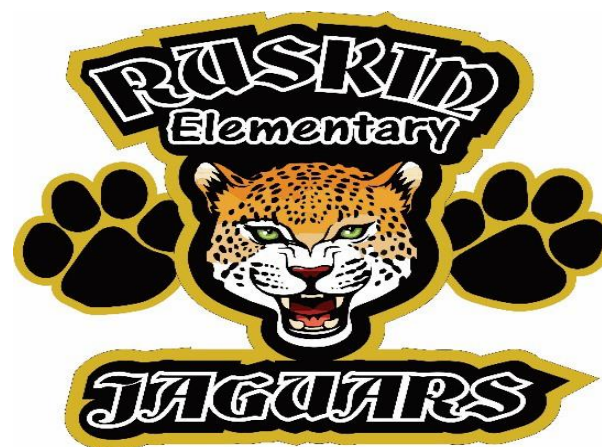
Parent and Family Engagement Standards
