Classes begin promptly at 9 AM and end at 4 PM, Monday – Friday.

Early Drop-Off: Students can be dropped off in the car line starting at 8:25 AM. Car line closes at 8:55 AM.

Late Arrivals: If a student arrives after car line closes, they will be considered "tardy". At this point, an adult must accompany the student to our front office and sign them in; the student will receive a classroom pass to present to their teacher.

Early Dismissals: Students can be signed out early *until* 3:15 PM. If they are signed out before 12:30 PM, they will be considered absent; beyond 12:30 PM will be considered an "early dismissal".



Excused Absences/Tardies:

Per Bryan County Schools 2019-2020 Parent/Student Handbook, absences and tardies will be excused by a medical note or other circumstances as outlined in the BCS Parent/Student Handbook.
