USE OF AUTHORIZATION EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS

POLICY: EBCF

ADOPTED: JULY 11, 2017

The RSU #56 Board recognizes that medical emergencies may arise on school property that warrant the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). The school unit has an AED for use in such emergencies. The Superintendent is responsible for implementing the AED program and all necessary administrative procedures. The Superintendent may delegate specific responsibilities concerning the AED program to administrators, or other appropriate school employees as he/she deems appropriate.
