

COACHES' ORIENTATION

The RSU #56 Board of Directors believes that the extracurricular program is an important part of the school system. Through extracurricular activities students learn the value of teamwork and citizenship. The Board of Directors believes in providing a quality extracurricular program with qualified trained coaches and advisors.

Prior to the beginning of each season, the Athletic Director and/or his designee, working with the appropriate principal, will provide coaches with orientation and training. The orientation and training of coaches will include but not be limited to a review of RSU #56's extracurricular policies and programs, coaches' responsibilities, league rules and regulations, Maine Principals Association policies, student policies contained within the athletic handbook and student handbooks and sexual harassment training. In addition, the instrument and procedure used to evaluate coaches will also be shared.

Prior to coaching, the Athletic Director will have each coach sign off as having been through orientation per the Coaches' Orientation Policy Procedure.
