

PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

RSU #56 shall provide appropriate programs for students with limited English proficiency to assist them in attaining English proficiency and meeting state and local academic achievement standards in compliance with applicable federal and state requirements. The School unit shall also provide for opportunities for parent involvement in their children's education as required by federal law.

The Superintendent is responsible for developing and implementing the school unit's LAU plan and any necessary administrative procedures. The Superintendent may delegate specific responsibilities to building administrators or others as he/she deems appropriate.
