

### **STUDENT ASSESSMENT**

The Board recognizes that Maine law requires each school administrative unit to use multiple assessment methods to measure student achievement of the Learning Results, including the *Guiding Principles*. The Board also recognizes the value of assessment in informing and improving instruction.

Through this policy, the Board adopts and directs the Superintendent/ designee to implement and oversee an assessment system for the RSU 56 schools that will accomplish these objectives. The Superintendent shall be responsible for reviewing the assessment system for compliance with applicable statutes and rules and for certifying to the Commissioner that it is in compliance with Maine Department of Education standards.
