The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$ 13,179.36, Escrow checks totaling \$156,030.33, Cooperative checks totaling 380.76, and Activity checks totaling \$21,412.89.

The Elementary Principal reported that Grandparents lunch at the Elementary school has been rescheduled until October due to lack of kitchen help. The elementary has 6 EL students. The AIMSwebPlus test has been given and improvement is needed. The students will test again in December and again at the end of the school year. There were 66 students that participated in Miles of Smiles. Michael Foods has graciously donated funds to be used to give each K-6 student a book. They will receive these books each month from

September until May. Thank you Michael Foods! The Elementary student council presented the Board of Education, Mr. Alexander and Mrs. Gilsdorf with giant Thank-you cards for the improvements to their learning environments.

The Superintendent mentioned that NASB/NCSA state convention will be Nov. 20-22 in Omaha. October 2<sup>nd</sup> will be Parent Teacher conferences. There will be student leaders to give tours of the newly remodeled buildings. Federal applications are progressing with Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> deadlines. The sprinkler project is almost complete. Mr. Fehringer will be adding grass seed this week. Mr. Alexander would like the building & grounds committee to meet regarding future remodeling to include ADA and Title IX compliance. Prochaska and Assoc. will be working on a pictorial drawing.

Committee reports included: Americanism/Civics. Christy Mackeprang gave a report to the board. She has met with Mr. Kuchar and Mr. Fehringer in order to be compliant with LB 399. There were no other reports.

The Board discussed the State School Board convention and teacher sick bank request. Bloomfield will host this year's D-4 Girls and Boys Cross Country tournament. Bloomfield has applied once again to host the District One Act plays.
