Our Path to First Choice No.2 2018/19

Welcome back! It is exciting to have you back to work with our students for the 2018/19 school year. Please know that we appreciate all you do, and you do make a difference.

Our Path Topic

Our 2018/19 Strategic Plan is about ready to go. Although there are 2-3 target numbers we need, we can start the work. Many things are in process, but many yet to start. Today, we will look at our first objective.

WASD plans to 'Continuously improve the district culture and climate. The areas in which we plan to focus are communications, relationships, social emotional learning, attendance, transparency, ethics process, strategic focus, retaining employees, and stakeholder trust and support.

We plan to measure our success in achieving this objective through stakeholder satisfaction with communication, stakeholder trust/support, staff and student attendance rates, number of students appropriately referred for Tier 2/3 social emotional learning interventions, and employee turnover rate.

Our Targets are:

- 95% of our students will miss less than 15 days annually by 2023/24 school year.
- 95% attendance (sick & unpaid leave) of their contracted work year by 2023/24.
- 80% parent satisfaction with District communication by 2021/22.
- 90% employee satisfaction with District communication by 2021/22.
- XX% retention rate for support staff (no % due to not having current rate accumulated, yet)
- At least one Admin/Board activity by 2021/22.
- 100% audits with no penalties and no repeated finding from one to next audit by 2023/24.

Some of the initiatives to achieve these targets are:

- Establish an Attendance Team.
- Continue Check and Connect (6-9).
- Establish Elementary Student Assistance Program.
- Develop a place on website for processes for easy stakeholder access.
- Setup & train on SAIP module in Sapphire.
- Establish month recognitions and awards for attendance.
- Develop a District newsletter.
- Finalize Tier 1 curriculum for every course.
- Develop list of activities to include all Team Members.
- Develop Administration/Board activity.
- Provide training to appropriate staff pertaining to audit.

Over the next few weeks we will learn about each of our WASD Strategic Objectives. Throughout the school year, we will revisit each to learn more about progress. This approach is new, and will take a few years to establish the process. Nevertheless, great organizations operate with such strategy. Again, with being more strategic, the organization becomes more aligned with its goals and objectives, more accountable, and more focused.
