TARDY POLICY

We understand that every once in while life is going to happen and you may be a little late to a class or need to leave class to go to your locker or the restroom. So, we give you two tardies per six weeks without consequence. However, once you are tardy to class more than twice in a six weeks there are consequences. This includes first period.

<u>3rd tardy</u>= conference with Principal or Assistant Principal.

4th tardy= 1 day of Tschool Detention.

5th tardy = 2 days of Tschool Detention.

6th Tardy = 6 or more tardies will result in ISS and/or Saturday School.

T-school Detention is held on most Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:30-5:00. Transportation is not provided. Failure to attend T-school detention will result in a placement to in school suspension (ISS).

TARDY

Tardy means you are not in the classroom you are assigned to when the bell rings. The teacher shall record any student that is not in the room when the bell rings as tardy.

Any student that is tardy by more than five minutes shall be referred to the office.

The principal will monitor tardies through attendance records. Any student who receives more than three tardies in a six week period will be assigned to a minimum of 1.5 hours of after school detention. For each additional tardy the student may be assigned to an additional 1.5 hours of after school detention. Six tardies in one six weeks will result in ISS. Please understand that this is across all classes, not per class period.

All students entering class after the tardy bell shall be counted tardy unless they bring a note from another school staff with a valid excuse.
