 - You **may not** talk about Sarah Harms. This seems like a given and an obvious, but please refrain from doing so.
- Please include the following in order:
 - A title page stating the name of the scholarship, where you plan on attending school and what career you're planning on pursuing in your post-high school years.
 - The essay – (at least a page long, but if you have more than one page, not a problem)
 - Groton local form
 - Two recommendations (these **cannot** include the teacher mentioned in your essay)
