

Dear Winlock Family,

September 25, 2019

The purpose of this letter is to let you know about a written threat found today at Winlock High School. Our school district is committed to the safety and education of all our students. We also want to clearly communicate with families about safety issues when they arise.

During lunch, a handwritten message was found that indicated an explosive would go off on campus today. Staff immediately notified law enforcement and then evacuated students at Winlock High School and Middle School and sent them home. Once the building was cleared, explosive technicians and dogs searched the campus. Nothing was found.

The police department is now investigating the threat. Classes will resume as usual tomorrow, September 26, 2019, and all activities will continue as scheduled.

We take all threats to our school and students seriously and investigate them thoroughly. We wanted you to have the facts so you can discuss them with your child and emphasize the seriousness of this issue. If you discover anything that can help in the investigation, please contact us immediately.
