
Each teacher will send home a folder or agenda containing student papers and work samples daily that will keep parents updated on their child's progress.


Mountain View Elementary School provides opportunities for parents and community members to support the instructional program through the tutoring program for first through fourth grades.

Mountain View Elementary School partners with a local church to provide food backpacks for students who demonstrate an extreme need for this program.


Mountain View Elementary School along with local business, churches and the community provide school supplies for students who demonstrate this need.






