Award Amount: \$2,000

Application Deadline: Mar. 1, 2020

Student eligibility requirements:

- High school junior attending one of 53 Central Oklahoma Guidance Counselor Network high schools (see back of page).
- First in family to attend college (applicant's parents, stepparents or grandparents have not attended college).
- Agrees to complete series of college preparatory activities including summer employment or community service, and a college campus visit.
- Plans to enroll as a full-time student at an academically-accredited, nonprofit institution in the U.S.
- Unweighted GPA no greater than 3.79.

TO APPLY

- Visit OCCF.AcademicWorks.com.
- Click **Sign Up** to create a student account.
- Complete the **General Application** and the **High School Senior Student Application** and submit all required documents.
- Apply for the **New Opportunities Scholars** award by answering the Supplemental Questions.
- If recommended by the Scholarship Selection Committee, applicant and parent must sign a contract agreeing to complete college preparatory activities by Jan. 15 of senior year.
