AGRICULTURE

Agriculture Education is a comprehensive program offering a variety of one and two hour classes for students in grades 9 - 12. Classes offered include Ag. Science, Advanced Animal Science, Veterinary Science, Crop Science, Food Science & Technology, Landscape Design, Greenhouse Operations, Floriculture, Ag. Construction, Ag. Structures, and more!

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

Do you have an interest in cars? The Auto Tech. program is a 3-hour block class for juniors and seniors interested in becoming an automotive technician. Gain hands-on experience doing maintenance / repair work on vehicles in the shop, and see if this is a career path for you!

BUILDING TRADES

Do you have a passion for building things? Our Building Trades program may be for you. It allows you to explore careers in the construction and carpentry industries, while gaining hands-on experience on-the-job or in the shop. The program is a 3-hour block and is open to students in grades 11 & 12.



BUSINESS

Is business your interest? We offer a wide variety of one hour classes for students in grades 9 - 12 including Intro. to Business, Personal Finance, Accounting I, QuickBooks, Entrepreneurship, Computer Business Applications, Medical Administrative Assistant, and Graphic Arts.

CULINARY

Interested in food, flavor, and cuisine? Our Culinary Arts program will help you take your first step to a promising restaurant or food service career. This is a 3-hour block for juniors and seniors, offering courses in Baking & Pastry and Culinary Arts.

HEALTH SCIENCE

Interested in a health care career? Our Health Science 3-hour block program introduces you to the health care delivery system with hands-on training. Learn the basics of anatomy, physiology, medical terminology, infection control and more as you prepare to earn a Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) certification. Open to students in grades 11-12, with a new Health Science II Internship for seniors only.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
