Loss Control Services

MSMA provides loss control services through its own in-house Risk and Safety Manager. The Risk and Safety Manager works with each member school system to identify hazards and trends, to provide information and training, and to help reduce the number of losses. Our goal is to assist you in creating a safe and injury-free workplace environment. MSMA provides assistance with injury prevention, compliance (written, training, and inspectional requirement), loss control techniques, and safety committees. MSMA encourages developing a working relationship with us to help your school system reduce injuries and improve compliance as they go hand in hand.

Some of the loss control services provided by MSMA include:

- On-site safety program evaluations
- On-site (building) safety and improvement assessments
- Analysis of past losses, as well as current trends
- On-site educational meetings with administrators (trends, targeting ideas, and safety-related matters)
- Safety training programs including live presentations, train-the-trainer seminars, and online training
- Preliminary ergonomic workplace evaluations - (computer workstations and others)
- Safety Committee development and support
- Risk management consultations including technical assistance
