Varsity Boys Basketball

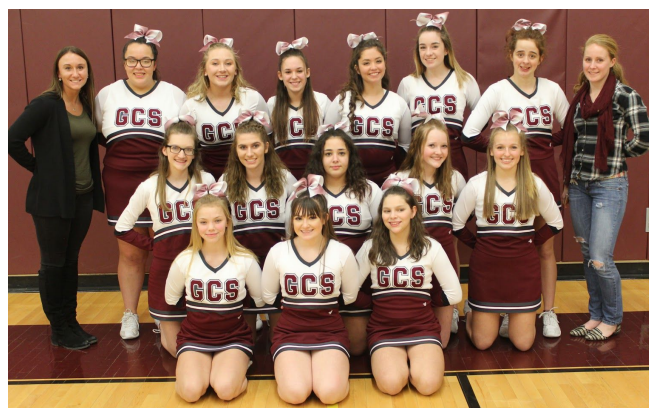
