

Rincon Valley Education Foundation After School Enrichment Program Registration Information Fall 2019 Session 2

The Rincon Valley Education Foundation is pleased to offer the After School Enrichment Program for the Rincon Valley Union School District. Classes are offered at all school sites in a wide range of areas, including art, science, sports, games and exploration. These classes provide additional opportunities for educational enrichment for children enrolled in the district.

How to Register: Complete a separate registration form for each student. If paying by check: A separate check or money order (payable to RVEF) is necessary for each student & each class.

Registration will be accepted in these three ways:

In Person: Register at the RVUSD District Office, 1000 Yulupa Avenue, Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm, at the front desk.

By Mail: Mail registration form along with check, money order, or credit card info to: Enrichment Class, PO Box 5574, Santa Rosa, CA 95402.

Confirmation: Registration will be confirmed by email, usually at least 3 days prior to the first day of class.

Minimum/ Maximum Enrollment: A minimum number of students is required for each course and is noted in the course description. If the minimum enrollment is not received the course will be cancelled and a full refund will be mailed. For classes exceeding the maximum, a waitlist will be established and students will be placed on the list in the order that their enrollment was received by the Foundation.

Scholarship A scholarship rate of 50% off the regular class fee is available for a **LIMITED NUMBER** of students who are eligible for free and reduced priced meals. *Scholarships are limited to one per child per class session*. If the student is eligible for a scholarship, please indicate this on the registration form. Please submit payment with the form for 50% of the class price.

Returned Check: All returned checks will be charged a \$17 processing fee.

Refund Request: Refund requests must be received before the first day of the scheduled class. A \$10 processing fee per student per course will be retained on all refunds. Should a course be cancelled by RVEF for any reason, the full fee will be refunded.

Student Conduct: Students attending enrichment classes must follow the District Code of Behavior and School Rules. The class instructor has the right to dismiss any student if the child is not behaving appropriately. This will be done without a refund.

Day Care Students: Students who are enrolled in the RVUSD day care program <u>must first check in with the</u> day care staff before they go to their enrichment class.

Emergency Class Cancellation: In the unlikely event that a class has to be cancelled on a day it is scheduled (i.e. instructor illness) students will be notified and parents will be notified as soon as possible. Due to weather, an outdoor class may be moved indoors or postponed.
