#### **Back to School Mailing:**

A mailing will be sent out by August 21 to all families containing a welcome letter, classroom placements, bus schedules, class supply lists, freereduced lunch forms, and other important back to school information. If you do not receive your mailing by August 26, please contact the school and we will get the information to you.

#### **Lunch Program:**

All kindergarten students will receive free breakfast this year. All students qualifying for reduced meals will also receive free breakfast and lunch. Breakfast rates are \$1.25 for students. Lunch rates increased to \$2.35 for Viking students and \$2.45 for Newfolden and High School Students. We implemented a new online payment system called SchoolPay. You can get there from our school website.

#### Free Reduced Forms:

Please take time to complete the free and reduced lunch forms that are included in the August mailing. Qualifying helps our food service program and it helps many of our academic programs as well. These dollars help us provide supplemental education services to students that need extra help. This is a yearly application. If you were approved in the past, you must get a new form completed and turned in prior to September 30 in order to be eligible to receive free/reduced meals. #### **Bus Route Information:**

You will receive a copy of the master bus routes in the August mailing. There are changes each year that could have affected which bus you ride and the time picked up. Please look over your child's pick up time. Reminder, children should be at stops 5 minutes prior to pick up time. If you have questions or if you need transportation and are not on the route lists, please contact Adam in the transportation office (218) 874-7291 or alokstad@mccfreeze.org and he will assist you. Reminder: When your child needs to ride a different bus home than they usually ride, a note is required. A phone call to the office can be made in lieu of a note.

#### CHROMEBOOK INFORMATION FOR PARENTS:



The MCC Chromebook Handbook is available on the school web site. We ask that parents of grades 9-12 students take time to review the handbook. Paper copies of required forms will be mailed out with the back to school mailing and are also available at school upon request. The handbooks explain student expectations, rules, proper use information, copies of forms, and insurance requirements. Insurance will remain \$50 this year and is required in order for student to take Chromebooks home. Free/Reduced lunch students will pay \$25 for insurance. Informational meetings and form collections will take place at Back to School night on August 28 for new students and students entering grade 9. Students in Grades 10-12 can bring in forms and payment to collect Chromebook. For questions prior to the meeting, please contact the district office (218) 874-8530.

#### FREEZE KIDS CARE PROGRAM

We are beginning our fifth year of Freeze Kids after school child care this year. Thank you to our families and coordinator Michele Audette for the programs success. The program can have 20 students. Some returning families have secured spots. The remaining spots will be held on a first-come/firstserve basis.

Hours of the program are from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on school days only. Families must complete a registration and make first weeks deposit. Drop-ins or partial week participants are accepted with one weeks notice. Registration forms and parent contracts are available on the school web site or you can request them from the school office. We will not not reserve forms via e-mail to preserve integrity of first-come/ first-serve. We will maintain a waiting list if the program fills. Rates are \$40 per week for a 5 day school week.
