Another threat was found today at Winlock High School, indicating there was an explosive device on campus. Staff immediately notified law enforcement and then evacuated students at Winlock High School and Middle School and sent them to Winlock Elementary School. Once the building was cleared, explosive technicians and dogs searched the campus. No explosives were found.

Law enforcement is now investigating the threat. They have assured us that classes may safely resume as usual tomorrow, October 3, 2019, and all activities will continue as scheduled. The Lewis County Police will join us tomorrow at a morning assembly at the high school/middle school. They will talk more about the legal consequences of making threats.

We take all threats to our school and students seriously and investigate them thoroughly. If you discover anything that can help in the investigation, please contact us immediately.
