Conflict

The main problem that the protagonist faces within the story.

Complications & challenges:

Sequence of events that stand in the way of the protagonist

Climax:

The turning point where the main problem begins to be solved

Resolution:

The solution to the main problem facing the protagonist



Characters:

Protagonist is the main character (hero)

Antagonist: character opposing the protagonist

Setting:

Time and place of the story

Theme:

The author's message and the deeper meaning of the story.

Point of View:

Who is telling the story and whose thoughts do we know?

Exposition: the beginning of the story where we find out basic information about characters, setting, and plot.

Rising Action: the events in the story that increase action and build suspense before reaching the climax.

Plot: the plan and sequence of events in a story.

Falling Action: any events that follow the climax and deal with the resolution of the conflict.
