Immunization Exclusion Day

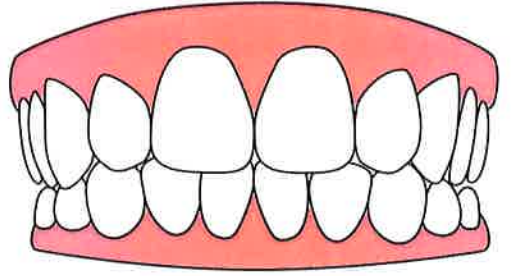
The cut-off for providing proof of current immunizations is October 4th. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to help you get your child up to date.

FLU IMMUNIZATION CLINIC

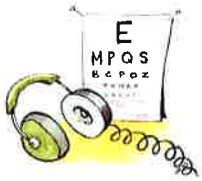
During enrollment over 150 students were signed up for the flu vaccine! These immunizations will be administered at school on October 22nd.



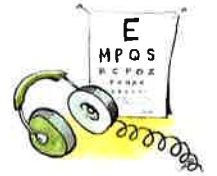
