MINUTES

1. Call To Order

The meeting was called to at 6:01 p.m.

In attendance were Superintendent Tim Van Tassel, Board Chair Erica Bromley, and Board members Geoff Davis, Kathy Williams and Kevin Williams.

2. Parent Survey

Superintendent Van Tassel reviewed some basic survey options with the Committee as a starting point.

The consensus recommendation is that the survey be issued to the full family population and not just those with students attending charter or magnet schools.

Existing required surveys were reviewed with the Committee.

Wording focus was discussed. Rather than asking those who have chosen to send their students to a charter or magnet school why they chose that option, the majority of the committee felt that it was more appropriate to ask which components are keys in your choice of school (location, STEM, Unified Arts, Technology, etc.).

Superintendent Van Tassel will draft a survey and share it with the Board for review. Individual comments can be sent to the Superintendent directly for aggregation. The survey can be issued during conference week in March. The survey can go to the existing emails we have within the District, and can be promoted via the Rivereast to reach those not sending students within the District. Surveys will be conducted using SurveyMonkey as the tool of choice.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:25 PM.
