SCHOLARSHIPS! Seniors - keep in mind that when applying to some colleges, you are considered automatically for some scholarships. Other scholarships and other colleges may require you to complete an admissions application, a general scholarship application, and/or individual scholarship applications. Please read carefully on the websites or speak with an admissions counselor from that school for further information. Ask for help! Start early on all scholarship applications and complete before the deadline if possible.

DUE OCTOBER 25 - HORATIO ALGER NATIONAL & STATE SCHOLARSHIPS - up to \$25,000 - full-time seniors who plan to pursue a bachelor's degree (can start at a 2-year college). Must demonstrate financial need, be involved in co-curricular and community service, display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, and have a minimum GPA of 2.0. Apply at www.scholars.horatioalger.org.

****DUE OCTOBER 29 - HEISMAN HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP - up to \$5000 - senior athletes who excel in the classroom, on the playing field, and in your community should apply at www.HeismanScholarship.com.**

DUE OCTOBER 31 - MASFAP WHO'S MAKING A DIFFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP - any 2019 senior graduating from a Missouri High School planning to attend a private, public 2 or 4 year institution, or vocational-technical school in MO should apply. Go to www.myscholarshipcentral.org to apply.

DUE NOVEMBER 5 - ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP - 500 4-YEAR AWARDS FROM \$4000 TO \$50,000 - seniors will be judged on Scholarship, Leadership, and Financial Need. Apply at enf.elks.org/mvs.

DUE NOVEMBER 15 - HAGAN SCHOLARSHIP - UP TO \$48,000 over 4 years, plus a Study Abroad, plus a Schwab Account - seniors with a 3.75 GPA, ACT Composite of 24, and financially eligible. Check this awesome scholarship out at www.hsfmo.org.

****DUE DECEMBER 3 - JOHN T. BELCHER SCHOLARSHIP - any senior may apply. Only one will be selected by our school board to be nominated to continue in the state process. Applications are in the Google classroom.**

DUE DECEMBER 31 (for 2019 graduates) - IMAGINE AMERICA SCHOLARSHIP - senior or recent graduates planning to attend a career school that participates in the Imagine America High School Scholarship Program. Apply online at www.imagine-america.org/applyforscholarships.

DUE FEBRUARY 15 - VFW AUXILIARY CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP - \$1000 - seniors who are a spouse, son, or daughter of a member of the VFW are eligible to apply. Go to the Senior Google Classroom for an application.

DUE APRIL 15 - VFW AUXILIARY MISSOURI PAST NATIONAL PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP - \$1800 AND \$1200 - seniors who are the child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a MO VFW or VFW Auxiliary member (current or deceased) should apply. Go to the Senior Google Classroom for an application.

****DUE APRIL 15 - KIDS' CHANCE OF MISSOURI SCHOLARSHIP - amount may vary depending on funds available - any child between the ages of 17 and 22 of an employee who was seriously injured or died in a work related accident or from an occupational disease covered and compensated by Workers' Compensation. Go to the Senior Google Classroom for an application.**

****NO APPLICATION DEADLINE - early application is encouraged - PUBLIC SERVICE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE'S CHILD SURVIVOR GRANT - amount will vary depending on the school you are enrolled with full time - senior who is the child of a public safety officer or a MODOT employee who was permanently disabled or killed in the line of duty or engaged in state work is eligible to apply. Application in the Senior Google Classroom.**
