

**Monitoring/Reporting Violation**  
**Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)**  
**MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The Cherokee ISD water system PWS ID 2060010 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

**Cherokee ISD monitoring personnel will put in place reminders to file the necessary reports with TCEQ as required by 30 TAC §290, Subchapter F (stated above). The person responsible for this will be required to complete training in this area to remedy the issue.**
