Mrs. Meiwes' Ag Education Adventures

Mrs. Meiwes' agricultural education department has hit the ground running again this year! We are extremely excited about the opportunities that will be available for the students this year. Here is a little update about what we have been up to in class and FFA the past few weeks.

The introductory courses have been learning about the basics of agriculture and FFA. Exploratory agriculture students have been learning about the history, future, and importance of agriculture. They have created a timeline of inventions and explored careers that fit their personalities within agriculture. Agricultural science students have been learning about the FFA organization and preparing for their upcoming Greenhand Conference on September 26 in Riverton. Topics have included the history, traditions, and opportunities in FFA. They have been working diligently and challenging each other to learn the FFA Creed.

The animal science classes have been learning the basics of critters. The animal science course has been studying the domestication and naming of animals. They each chose an animal in which they will work with to create a Producer's Management Guide throughout the yearlong course. Their projects have included the domestication of their animal as well as creating a dichotomous key to help us in identification methods. In a similar manner, the vet science students have been starting with the basics of cell structure and functions as well as anatomy and physiology. They have enjoyed learning tissues by dissecting a chicken wing and identifying tendons versus ligaments as well as the three types of tissues.

The agribusiness students have been learning about the government's role in agriculture as well as risk management in agriculture. They are taking the beginning steps in learning how to establish their financial future and the impact that it has on agriculture and the economy. Meanwhile, the agricultural welding class covered shop safety and has begun their arc welding skills in the shop. The advanced classes are beginning on bale rings and other projects for themselves and community members. If you have ideas or need anything, please feel free to contact the agricultural education department.

On another note, FFA is gearing up for the year with their activities! We had a great turnout at our FFA Back to School BBQ on August 16 and are looking forward to the Horse Judging contest on October 11. The members will be preparing before and after school in order to learn the content and have a successful experience. In addition, members will be helping at Old Iron Days again this year on September 26 and 27. Last but not least, the chapter will be selling fruit, meat, and desserts from October 1-October 16.
