


The Purformance score measures concrete, quantifiable measures of educational achievement, growth, and carear-readiness at various points along the K-12 spectrum. Purformance metrics hold ERAs accountable for whether students consistently attain positive educational outcomes and measures whether the students of a particular ERA or school are againing the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in the next steps of their education, including post-pleadation.

Academic Achievement: Status

Status is a measure of academic performance at a given point in time.
