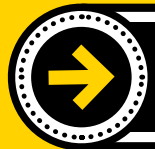

## SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITIONS

### DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARSHIP INVITATIONAL (DSI): Up to \$64,000

The Distinguished Scholarship Invitational is one of the area's most prominent scholarship competitions, including **THREE \$64,000** Harry Gore Memorial Scholarships—**THREE OF THE LARGEST** annual undergraduate scholarships in Kansas.

**TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:**

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

### ANNA KATHLEEN WALSH ENGLISH SCHOLARSHIP: Up to \$50,000

An award covering most tuition, fees, books and on-campus housing at resident rates for an incoming freshman majoring in English or creative writing. Scholarship amount is split over four years or until bachelor's degree completion, whichever comes first.

**TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:**

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year
- Must declare English or creative writing as a major
- Must compete in the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational

## W. FRANK BARTON SCHOOL OF BUSINESS ALLEN, GIBBS & HOULIK L.C. SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION:

↘ **Up to \$48,000**

Eligible students compete for scholarships in various amounts—including the **\$48,000 CLAY BARTON SCHOLARSHIP**.

### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Declare a business major
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

## COLLEGE OF APPLIED STUDIES KLOSE SCHOLARS COMPETITION:

↘ **Up to \$20,000**

The Doris and Ralph Klose Scholarship competition is available to high school seniors who declare a major in math or science education at WSU. Winners will be offered a financial aid package that includes a combination of scholarships. The Klose Scholarship covers the average cost of **TUITION, BOOKS** and **FEES** during junior and senior years at WSU as long as eligibility is maintained.

### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Declare a major in math or science teacher education
- Meet the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 24, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite score of 1180, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

## COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING WALLACE INVITATIONAL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS IN ENGINEERING (WISE):

↘ **\$28,500**

Each fall, the Wallace Invitational for Scholarships in Engineering (WISE) awards **10** prospective engineering students **\$28,500 SCHOLARSHIPS** over four years of study.

### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Declare an engineering major
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

### KOCH SCHOLARS COMPETITION: \$30,000-\$45,000

High school seniors are invited to compete for **SEVEN HONORS COLLEGE KOCH SCHOLARSHIPS** worth up to **\$7,500** each year for in-state tuition, fees, room and board or up to **\$11,250** for out-of-state students.

#### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Declare a business or engineering major
- Meet the eligibility criteria and be admitted to the Honors College:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.7 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280

#### ELIGIBLE MAJORS:

computer engineering, computer science, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, accounting, economics, finance or management information systems

### LENORA MCGREGOR ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP: Up to \$26,000

Awards up to **\$26,000** over four years of study to an incoming freshman who has demonstrated academic excellence and intellectual curiosity.

#### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Meet the minimum eligibility criteria for admission to the Honors College:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.7 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280

## MARK AND STACY PARKINSON SCHOLARSHIP FOR FIRST GENERATION IMMIGRANT STUDENTS:

### UP TO \$34,000

A \$8,500/year scholarship geared toward first generation, immigrant students with preference toward DACA or other undocumented students.

#### TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Be a graduate from a Kansas high school
- Submit WSU admission materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Meet the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA
  - Submit the DSI scholarship application by Nov. 1
  - Compete in the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational on Nov. 23

- Declare an entrepreneurship major
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280 or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

📌 **FOUR-YEAR, FULL-RIDE  
SCHOLARSHIP**

A **FULL-RIDE AWARD** geared toward minority students majoring in business or education who demonstrate financial need.

### To be eligible to compete, you must:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Nov. 1, 2019
- Meet the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA, AND
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 21, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1060

**FINAL INTERVIEWS WILL BE HELD IN JANUARY 2020.**

## PASSAGE 2 SUCCESS SCHOLARSHIP:

📌 **\$8,000 - \$20,000**

.....  
A special award for at least **TEN FIRST-GENERATION STUDENTS**, with financial need, who compete in the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational. Awards are dispersed in amounts ranging from **\$2,000-\$5,000** per year.

### To be eligible to compete, you must:

- Be a 2020 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2019
- Meet one of the following criteria:
  - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
  - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
  - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
  - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year
- Meet the WSU priority date of Dec. 1 for submission of the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Students who are ineligible to complete a FAFSA will be contacted to provide a separate statement describing their financial need
- Recipients will be required to participate in the Passage 2 Success Program

### FRESHMEN MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS: \$8,000 - \$24,000

- \$2,000 - \$4,000 a year for Kansas residents
- \$3,000 - \$6,000 a year for non-residents
- Scholarship awarded over four years with eligibility
- Award offers are based on high school GPA and national test score (ACT/SAT)
- Nov. 1 priority date for consideration

### WSU HONORS COLLEGE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,000

- \$500 a year over two years for incoming freshmen who are fully admitted to WSU and to the WSU Honors College.
- Nov. 1 priority date for consideration

### WSU NATIONAL MERIT AND NATIONAL HISPANIC RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS: \$50,000

- \$20,000 for the first year
- \$10,000 for each of the next three years
- Good for four years with eligibility

### TRANSFER MERIT SCHOLARSHIP: \$4,000 - \$6,000

- \$2,000 - \$3,000 for two years for new, incoming domestic transfer students coming directly to WSU from another institution with at least 12 credit hours but less than 90 and working on their first bachelor's degree.

### → IN-STATE OR REDUCED TUITION

Students from Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Texas and Wisconsin may qualify for in-state or reduced tuition.
